- St Margaret, Roath
- St Martin, Roath
- St Saviour, Roath
- St German, Roath where lunch will be served
- St Mary, Butetown
- SS Dyfrig & Sampson, Grangetown
- St Augustine, Penarth, where tea will be served

We return to the station not later than 6pm.

We are offering an optional extra for all participants in the Saturday Tour who are in Cardiff on the Friday afternoon, before the Tour. There will be a visit to Llandaff Cathedral, just outside the City centre, at 3 p.m. Members make their own way by bus 24/25 from City centre or taxi to the Cathedral. At the same time, we hope to see the modernist chapel of St Michael's College, Llandaff, adjacent to the Cathedral. This is a fine work by George Pace who was responsible for the restoration of the Cathedral after War damage.

On Saturday participants should make their own way to Cardiff and meet to board the coach by 10.00 a.m at Cardiff Central station.
