This is a paper by Bishop Frank Sargeant and it comprises an extended review of Canon Peter Green's *Manchester Guardian* articles, published during the First World War. Canon Green was an accomplished writer whose by-line was 'Artifex'.

He dealt with the issues faced by parishioners in a poor Salford parish, coping with the privations of wartime as well as endemic poverty. The Society published Bishop Sargeant's biography of this devoted pastor in 2011. Peter Green stood in the catholic tradition of Anglicanism and was without doubt an outstanding parish priest.
