### **Leicester Tour**

Saturday 14th July 2018

This Tour is planned and led by Stephen Savage to whom completed booking forms should be sent. It is a one-day visit comprising a walking tour of churches in the town centre in the morning followed by a coach tour farther afield after lunch.

The churches we plan to visit are:

- St Andrew's, Jerrom Street (George Gilbert Scott, 1862)
- St Mary de Castro (Medieval & later)
- St Nicholas (Norman)

Lunch break

After which we meet the coach at the Cathedral at 1.45pm. You may choose to make a short visit to the Cathedral, formerly the parish church of St Martin before boarding the coach.

- St James the Greater, London Road (H.L. Goddard, 1901/14) Romanesque
- St Hugh's, Eyres Monsell (Basil Spence, 1957)
- St Thomas, South Wigston (Stockdale Harrison, 1892/93)

Participants should make their own way to Leicester Station. You will be met by Stephen at 10:30 at the station and we walk to St Andrew's, Jerrom Street. After St Andrew's we visit two other churches, reaching St Nicholas at lunchtime.

Lunch is at your own expense – eating places are plentiful in the town centre near St Nicholas. If you bring your own packed lunch, drinks are available at St Nicholas.

The cost per person is £30.00.
