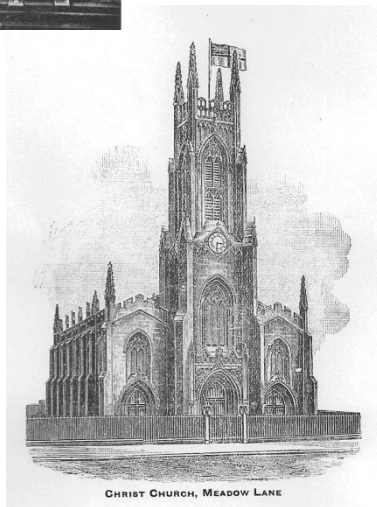

Churches in Leeds were built by some excellent local architects and by the nationally known great names. Anglo-Catholic priests have tended to work in the poorer areas of industrial cities and so the fine buildings there have been vulnerable to closure and possible demolition when redevelopment has occurred. Fortunately many wonderful church buildings remain throughout the city. This book tells the story of five of the lost churches of Leeds. There are some surprising items here – and some wider issues viewed from a local perspective. It is intended as a companion volume to Michael Yelton's *Empty Tabernacles: Twelve Lost Churches of London* - and "...perhaps others could be encouraged to write about such lost churches in other parts of the country before they are forgotten entirely".
